1. A short introduction about yourself as a dance maker
Tell us what kind of dance or movement you've made so far, and what styles or vibes you enjoy creating.

What would you like to explore with us? Some examples:

- Name A solo dance for a theatre stage
- 3 A group piece for 4 disabled dancers
- A beach dance film featuring a dancer with crutches
